INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT

Your illness or admission to hospital may lead to questions concerning faith and spirituality. Our pastors are willing to talk to you and listen to your concerns.

CHAPEL

You can visit the chapel, a place of prayer and contemplation, at any time during the day or night. It is located on the first floor and indicated with a yellow arrow.

PRAYER AND HOLY COMMUNION

Prayers are held in the chapel every weekday from 12.45 to 13.00. Every Sunday and Holy Day a Holy Communion or prayer service is held at 10.45.

If you would like to join a service in the chapel on a Sunday or holy day, please contact a member of the nursing staff.

Volunteers are ready to accompany you to the chapel, in a wheelchair or bed if necessary.

You can also follow chapel services and prayers in the Gasthuisberg campus directly via the OctopUZ screen. To do so tune in to the UZ Leuven channel (channel 1).

HOLY COMMUNION

Please ask a member of the nursing staff if you would like to receive Holy Communion. On Sundays volunteers provide Holy Communion between 10.00 and 11.30. On Wednesdays and Fridays it is provided by a pastor between 13.00 and 14.00.
